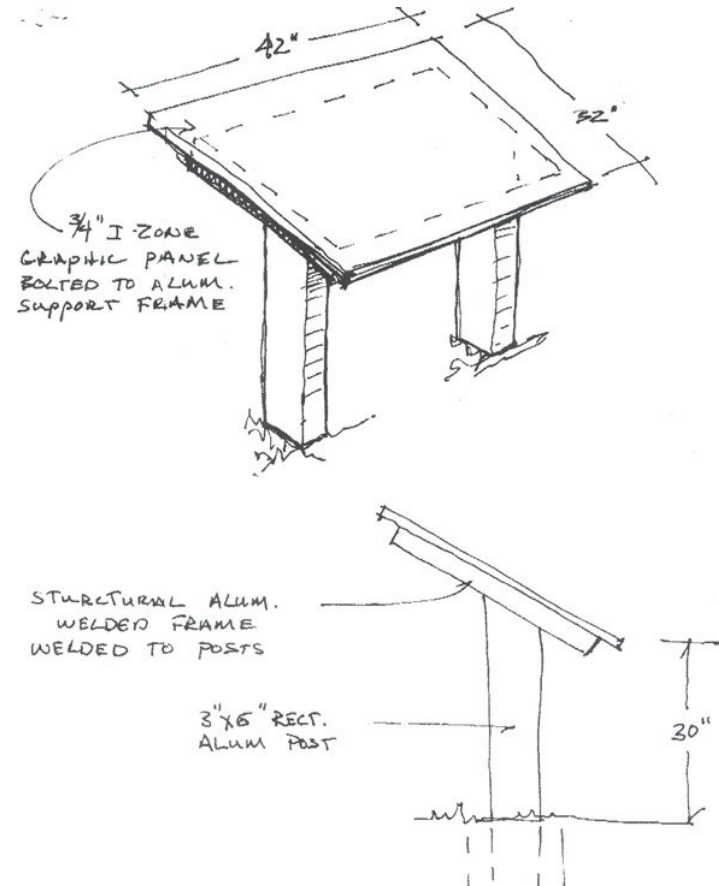


Five Mile House 2008 Improvement Project Cost Projections

Interpretive Signs - Two interpretive signs (above) are planned. One will tell the history and story of the Five Mile House and the other sign will feature the tourism sites in Coles County and surrounding area. These will be located in the patio area along the new sidewalk.
